

DRONE SAFETY IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY

Know the rules before you fly



DOs

DON'Ts



GET PERMISSION TO FLY

All of Malta's airspace is controlled. Seek permission from the Civil Aviation Directorate @ Transport Malta before you fly, by clicking [here](#).



FLY IN FAVOURABLE CONDITIONS

Only operate your drone during day time and do not fly in bad weather such as wind, clouds and fog.



LINE OF SIGHT

Always keep your aircraft within your visual line of sight and within the approved designated area.



KNOW YOUR CRAFT

Be sure to know all the main characteristics of your drone and its safe piloting principles



RESPECT PRIVACY

Ask for permission before capturing images in public areas



AVOID AIRCRAFT

Do not interfere with aircraft operations and do not fly any closer than 5km from the airport perimeter. Remain clear of heliports.



KEEP YOUR DISTANCE

Do not fly over people, buildings or vehicles. Do not operate your drone any higher than 200 feet above ground level.



AVOID CROWDS

Avoid flying close to large groups of people and remain at least 50m away.



FLY SOBER

Do not fly whilst under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances.



FIRST RESPONDERS

Do not interfere with first responders
